How Do I Carpool?

It's hard to pool resources when you don't know people, but the Internet has made it very easy to carpool. Just go to <http://analyhighschool.org/carpoolform.html>.

Or you can fill out the back of this flyer. It's not complicated.

1. Fill in what days/times you **need a ride** and the general location of pickup (e.g., near 116 and Bloomfield).
2. Circle what days (if any) can you **give a ride** (that's not required but it might help). What city or area are you coming from & returning to?
3. Watch as others sign up. You'll receive an email notice when the list of commuters is updated.
4. Search the online database for people whose needs match yours and contact matches with a suggestion to carpool.
5. Start carpooling!

Why carpool?

The advantage in financial savings alone is obvious. It also helps save the environment. For every gallon you save, one pound of toxic and carcinogenic pollutants and 20 pounds of carbon dioxide do not reach the atmosphere.

Tips for Successful Carpools

Once you have a match, discuss how to do it:

- *Communication:* have a way to contact one another in case of illness, etc.
- *Route and schedule:* where/when will you pickup and/or drop people.
- *Wait times:* How long do you wait? 2-3 minutes?
- *Car rules:* Do you permit smoking, drinking or eating?
- *Driving:* A reasonably clean car that runs well, with gas and insurance, is the minimum. Driving responsibly is important.
- *Side trips:* Yes or no? You might want to save these.
