

Reminders from Jeff Weaver, Chief of Police, Sebastopol

Analy High School is back in session and parking is at a premium.

So, how can you pick-up and drop-off your student or park in the area without receiving a \$40.00 citation.

DO: - Arrive early for school. There is no traffic at 7:15am but by 7:25am the area is congested. A few minutes makes a big difference.

DO: - Create your own "cell phone" parking area on Morris Street, Laguna Park Way, or elsewhere. Wait until your student calls or texts you; then drive to the school and get them. Or have them walk to you.

DO: - Use the Laguna High School parking lot when picking up students from after school activities. That's a safe option very close to both gyms.

DON'T: - Park (even for a moment), in the Resident Only Parking areas; they are reserved for area residents with permits 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

DON'T: - Wait in the Loading Zone in front of the Gym for your students. That's only for active loading/unloading with a three minute maximum.

DON'T: - Stop for any reason in the No Parking, No Stopping, No Standing zone at the intersection of Taft and Sunset Streets. Keep this area totally clear for pedestrian and vehicle safety.

DON'T: - Park in the main parking lot or parking lot near softball field in any space marked "staff". Only park in visitor parking or you will be towed.

The Sebastopol Police Department will be strictly enforcing parking regulations near the school. We would much rather have drivers follow the rules. Please help us with the goal.
