

Parent Information for Emergency Situations

During an actual emergency situation, in the Sebastopol area, where students and staff from Analy High School are affected, all parents should know and follow these simple guidelines:

- Depending on the nature of the emergency, students will either “*Duck and Cover*” and/or “*Shelter in Place*” within their classrooms or “*Evacuate*” to their designated areas. (These drills are practiced on a monthly basis)
- Police and Fire Officials are called immediately and will provide emergency assistance and traffic control.
- Analy High School’s “*Emergency Response Team*” has a systematic method for releasing students to parents. If you are unable to wait until the “*Student Release Procedures*” are followed, DO NOT come onto the main campus, but report to the student parking lot where school and emergency personnel will assist you.
- The recommended path to the student parking lot is via Hurlbut Avenue to High School road. (Emergency vehicles will be traveling via Main Street to High School road and may have the front of A.H.S. blocked off to all non-emergency vehicles.)
- Regular emergency updates will be issued through the “Analy News” electronic mail system and local radio stations. All parents are encouraged to sign up for the “Analy News” e-mails and may do so via the Analy Web Site at: www.analyhighschool.org.
