Scheduling/Length of Ceremony

The Commencement Ceremony will take place on **Friday, June 2, at 5:30pm**, on Karlson Field, and is expected to last 1.5 - 2 hours in length. Gates open at 4:30pm. Admission by ticket only, with the exception of children under five. Graduates should report to the Main Gym at 4:30pm.

Commencement Ceremony Tickets

Every graduating senior receives **SIX** free tickets to the ceremony to be distributed to family and friends. In addition to the six tickets provided, graduating seniors may purchase up to 10 additional tickets at a cost of \$5.00 each (cash only). Please complete the [Request for Extra Graduation Tickets](#) form included in this packet and submit to Sandra Jones, Vice Principals Secretary in the main office. Tickets will be distributed to graduating seniors following practice on Wednesday, May 31st. Bleachers on the home side of the stadium provide handicapped accessible seating for those that require assistance (seating is limited) and there is no reserved seating. Any attempt to reserve seating will be removed by AHS staff prior to the gates opening. Seniors must return all textbooks, library books, athletic uniforms/equipment and clear all debts prior to receiving tickets. Graduates and their families are asked to conduct themselves in a manner that does not draw attention to themselves and does not detract from the ceremony.

Attire for Commencement Ceremony

Dressy Casual **with graduation gown, cap and tassel** (no denim/sneakers/flip flops). Distribution of graduation gown, cap and tassel will be Tuesday, May 16th at LUNCH in the Quad. Graduation Requirements

In order to participate in the Commencement Ceremony and receive a diploma, students must complete the Graduation Requirements established by the West Sonoma County Union High School District and the State of California. In addition to academic graduation requirements students must have returned all of their textbooks and have cleared all debts owed. Students who have been placed on a Probationary Contract or who have been suspended will not be able to participate in the Commencement Ceremony.

Graduation Practice (Mandatory)

Seniors participating in the Commencement Ceremony must attend **all mandatory** practices. Please do not schedule work, appointments or other activities during graduation practice. Practice schedule; **Wednesday, May 31st, 1:00-3:00pm** AHS Main Gym/Karlson Field **and Thursday, June 1st, 1:00-3:00pm** AHS Main Gym/Karlson Field. We encourage students to wear sunscreen and bring water.

Diploma/Final Transcript

Students will receive a Diploma Cover at the Commencement Ceremony. Diplomas will be ready for pick up by student or parent/guardian in the Registrar Office starting in August. Diplomas will not be mailed home. To have your final transcript sent to your school of choice, please use the sign up list in the office of our Registrar, Nancy Siebert.
