



As a follow up to the letter you received on September 5th, the West Sonoma County Union High School district would like to make all families aware of an important free resource provided by the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors, the Sonoma County Counsel and the Sonoma County Office of Education.

**Three free clinics for DACA recipients who need assistance renewing their applications will be held on 9/20, 9/23, 9/28.** Immigration lawyers will provide assistance with the application and answer questions. Participants can also receive information about financial assistance towards the cost of the renewal.

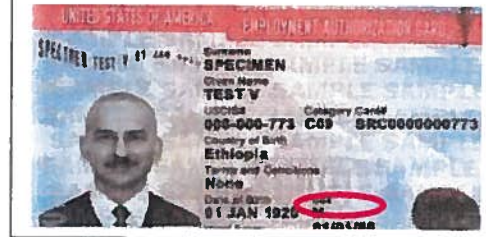
