

CELL PHONES & ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Cell phones are allowed on campus. However, cell phones must be turned off during class time unless otherwise deemed necessary for instruction by the teacher. If a student is found to be in violation, the following consequences will result:

First Offense: Teacher will confiscate cell phone and submit to the office. Cell phone will be released at the end of the school day to the student.

Second Offense: Student will be assigned an after school work program. Cell phone will be released at the end of the school day to the student.

Third Offense: Cell phone will be released to the to the parent or guardian only. Administration will meet with parent and student at this time to address the problem and inform that further offenses will lead to stronger disciplinary action.

Fourth Offense: Student will be suspended from school and placed on a probationary contract.

Further, electronic devices such as iPads, Tablets, and Laptops are not allowed during class time without teacher permission.

Students may not record any classroom activity at any time without the expressed written consent of the teacher. Video/audio recording violations may result in disciplinary action." (California Ed. Code 5151.2)
