2018 Senior Class Information Graduation

Scheduling/Length of Ceremony

The Commencement Ceremony will take place on **Thursday, May 31, at 5:00pm**, on Karlson Field, and is expected to last 1.5 - 2 hours in length. Gates open at 4:00pm. Admission by ticket only, with the exception of children under five. Graduates should report to the Main Gym at 4:00pm.

Commencement Ceremony Tickets

Every graduating senior receives **FIVE** free tickets to the ceremony to be distributed to family and friends. In addition to the five tickets provided, graduating seniors may purchase up to five additional tickets at a cost of \$5.00 each (cash only). Please complete the Request for Extra Graduation Tickets [Form](#) and submit to Sandra Jones, Vice Principals' Secretary. Tickets will be distributed to graduating seniors following practice on Tuesday, May 29. Bleachers on the home side of the stadium provide handicapped accessible seating for those who require assistance (seating is limited) and **there is no reserved seating**. Any attempt to reserve seating will be removed by AHS staff prior to the gates opening. Seniors must return all textbooks, library books, athletic uniforms/equipment and clear all debts prior to receiving tickets. Graduates and their families are asked to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects the significance of the event.

Attire for Commencement Ceremony

Dressy Casual **with graduation gown, cap and tassel** (no denim/sneakers/flip flops). Distribution of graduation gown, cap and tassel will be Tuesday, May 15 at LUNCH in the Quad. Graduation Requirements

In order to participate in the Commencement Ceremony and receive a diploma, students must complete the Graduation Requirements established by the West Sonoma County Union High School District and the State of California. In addition to academic graduation requirements students must have returned all of their textbooks and have cleared all debts owed. Students who have been placed on a Probationary Contract or who have been suspended will not be able to participate in the Commencement Ceremony.

Graduation Practice (Mandatory)

Seniors participating in the Commencement Ceremony must attend **all mandatory** practices. Please do not schedule work, appointments or other activities during graduation practice. Practice schedule; **Tuesday, May 29, 1:30-3:00pm** AHS Main Gym and **Wednesday, May 30, 1:00-3:00pm** AHS Main Gym. We encourage students to wear sunscreen, bring water and sunglasses as we will also be on the field.

Diploma/Final Transcript

Students will receive a Diploma Cover at the Commencement Ceremony. Diplomas will be ready for pick up by student or parent/guardian in the Registrar's Office beginning in August. **Diplomas will not be mailed home**.
